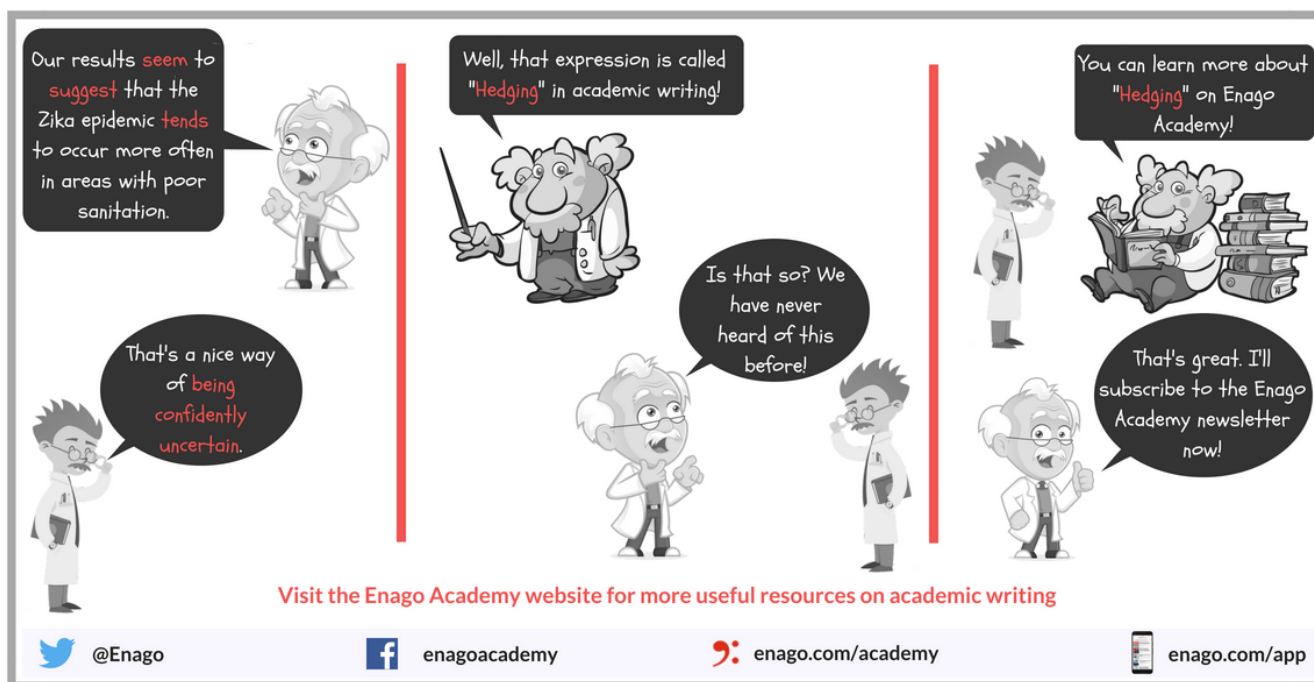


Academic Cartoon on Hedging
