Rules of Capitalization



Capitalize names of people, places, trade names, and organizations.



Capitalize titles and honorifics that come before a name.



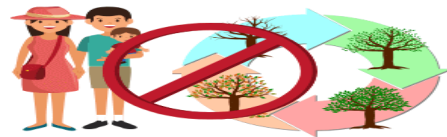
Capitalize races and languages



Capitalize the days of the week, months, and special days



Capitalize historical periods and events



Do not capitalize seasons and relatives
