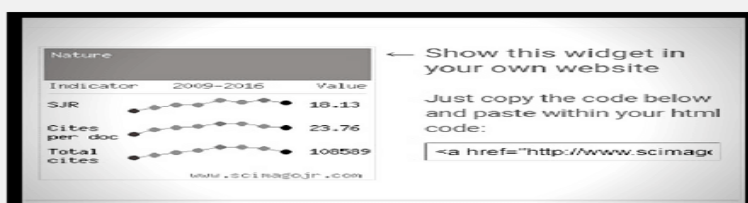

- 3 **Compare** and **analyze** journals by subject area and category.
- 4 Retrieve data from the **Scopus® database**.
- 5 **Embed** the relevant journal metrics into your blog/website.



- 6 **Filter** your search by including/excluding **open access journals**.
- 7 Get complete details on the SCImago Journal Rankings (**SJR**s) and **h-indices** for various journals.
- 8 **Analyze** the year-wise performance of various journals.
- 9 **Download** the searched data for future reference.
- 10 Use these data to **identify** a few journals for your publishing needs!
